SUMMARY OF MAIN QUALIFICATIONS

His professional career started in 1976 as a trainee with Engenheiros Construtores, Lda. A year later he took up a job as a clerk with Consórcio Azevedo Campos SARL (currently CETA SARL). Then he interrupted his professional activities to continue his studies at the Maputo Industrial Institute (IIM). During his last year at the IIM he worked as Counterpart in the Civil Engineering area of BUREP – the Mozambican-Bulgarian Studies and Projects Bureau.

After graduating from the IIM he returned to CETA as a Medium-level Engineer – class “C”, “B” and “A”, having assumed the management/co-management of the Nampula – Rio Ligonha and Rio Ligonha – Alto Molócue Road works and the Maputo City “A” Basin Drainage System.

Afterwards, he led the Maputo City Waste Water Drainage and Purification System construction works.

After having obtained his Honours degree in Civil Engineering at the Eduardo Mondlane University he led the Maintenance Unit of the Basin “A” Drainage Systems, now as a Civil Engineer. Later on he was appointed Project Director in Maputo City.

He has experience in property valuation, as a result of his practical activities as independent consultant.

As civil engineering consultant he participated in the preparation of the Nampula Town urban paving project and the Nampula Province rural roads project, both financed by the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands.

In 1993 he was appointed Director-General of DOMUS - Sociedade de Gestão Imobiliária SARL [Real Estate company] and simultaneously started teaching at the Eduardo Mondlane University / Faculty of Engineering, in charge of the Construction Technology I, II and III courses, with the category of Assistant.

He chaired two arbitration committees, the first one opposing the Construtora Mondego company against the Ministry of Fisheries regarding the Maputo Fishing Port construction works, financed by the Japanese government, with a disputed amount of about USD 120,000 (one hundred and twenty thousand American dollars); and the second one opposing the Concor Lda. Company and Sanam – Sociedade Algodoeira do Namialo [a cotton company] regarding the construction of the Namialo cotton ginnery, financed by the World Bank, with a disputed value of about USD 1,000,000 (one million American dollars). Both arbitrations had a final outcome accepted by the parties in dispute.

After in 2004 having concluded his Post-Graduate Course in Roads Engineering-Honours degree , in January 2005 he was appointed Director of Studies and Projects in the Maputo City Council, through a public application procedure.

He occupied the position of Director General of ANE-National Road Administration, in June 2005 to July 2007, after having been assessed by a panel composed of the 5 members of the Institution's Board of Directors.
